TECHNICAL TIPS

Make sure you use graphite dry lubricant for your strikes and locks!

Electric strikes are being used more than ever in today's installations due to their practical and effective method of locking doors and gates.

Having been installed over a period of time, one of the most common problems associated with electric strikes is the mechanism jamming or becoming sticky.

When servicing this fault, some installers make the mistake of lubricating the strike with machine oil, or even worse, motor oil. Whilst both of these products act as a lubricant, they also attract dust and grit, that in time causes more trouble than was found with the initial fault.

Graphite powder acts as a lubricant suitable for the mechanical components of an electric strike, with the added benefit of being a dry lubricant. This ensures that dust and grit do not adhere to the strike's components upon contact, thus providing an effective and reliable method of lubrication when needed.
